

# Safety Board Game

Obtain a fairly large piece of cardboard paper to make a safety board game with. Make a 'track' on the cardboard winding any which way you want, that is about two inches wide. Divide the track up into about thirty or forty different spaces. Select some spaces as a green safe zone, and other spaces to draw a card. On the cards, write various safety phrases. Here are some examples:

**Play with Matches, Loose a turn**

**Say No to a bad touch, move forward three spaces.**

**Run away from a stranger, take two turns.**

**Crawl low in a fire, move forward three spaces**

**Wear your helmet when you ride your bike, move forward 3 spaces.**

**Touch a gun, move back 5 spaces.**

**Dial 911 in an emergency, move forward 3 spaces, Exc.**

Give each child some sort of a token and play the game by having each child roll a dice, and move their token forward to that space. If it is a safe space, they are fine.

If it is a danger space, they draw a card, and do as it says. The first one to get to the end wins. Feel free to decorate your safety board by gluing on pictures of firemen, guns, and other safety related pictures outside the playing spaces.
