ditch. But most important is to pay attention to your surroundings. Look for people who are sitting in their cars. You never know when some looney-toon might decide to peel out from his driveway. And look for things like potholes in the road or other obstacles that could get in the swerve to avoid something, be sure to swerve away form the road! If a dog runs out in front of you or you start to lose control, head for the road. Save the stunts for bike parks or times when there aren't any cars around. A second rule is to always remember: if you ever have to There are several important rules to remember when you're out and about riding your bike. One is to never try to do tricks on or near the
