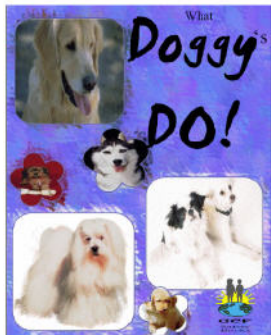


What Doggy's Do...
