




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## I could come to you Daddy?


That's right. Me or Mommy Bear. Anytime you need to, for anything in the whole wide world.




But what if Little Bear is afraid?




Even if someone was doing something that was hurting Little Bear or making him feel bad?










Think about it. If you were stuck in a bad situation, wouldn't it make you feel better having others there to help you?


But what if Little

But there are some things that Little Bears can never promise.


One of those things is keeping secrets from your parents. All people should know that isn't a promise you can keep, and they shouldn't expect you to keep it.




But what if talking about it might get somebody into trouble?

After all, nobody like it when people are upset with eachother, especially little bears.





But would you still love me afterward, no matter what?







But what if Little Bear thought something would make you upset, and he didn't want to make you upset?


